### Facility Information

Carnation Elementary is located on Hwy 203 and Morrison Street within the northern boundary of the City of Carnation, Washington, about 25 miles east of Seattle.

In October 1999, the remodeled Millennium Wing was dedicated. This wing is currently the home to CE Multi-age Team. Carnation Elementary is a focal point for our extended community as seen by the extensive use by youth sports teams/leagues, scouts, and adults from the community.
