Application Procedures and Policies

TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

All applicants must complete and sign the enclosed application materials and return them to Eagle Rock **no later than March 2, 2007**. All complete applications will be considered equally and placed into the “lottery”. ***FAMILIES MUST ATTEND ALL REQUIRED PARENT/ STUDENT MEETINGS OR YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE PROCESSED TO BE PLACED INTO THE LOTTERY.*** If openings should occur after the “lottery”, the pool of applicants that completed the application process will be considered first, late applicants may be considered on a space ability basis and will be subject to the administrator’s approval.

Other factors may affect the acceptance of your application status including the staff’s evaluation of the educational needs of our current students, sibling preference, and the need to maintain an overall gender balance in grade levels.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANT POOL:

Parents are **required** to schedule and attend the following application activities:

- Parent Observation Visits 9:45 A.M.– January 16th, 18th, 23rd, 25th, February 1st, 6th, 8th, 13th, 15th, 27th and March 1st. **(Adults only please)**
- Student & Parent Visit 2:00 P.M. – January 16th, 18th, 23rd, 25th, February 1st, 6th, 8th, 13th, 15th, 27th and March 1st. **(No siblings please)**
- Parent Information Night March 8th (6-7pm at Eagle Rock)
- It is the parents’ responsibility to schedule the observations and visitations by calling the school office at (425) 844-4900. Parent observations and student visits must be complete by March 2nd. Failure to meet these requirements may result in the student’s name being dropped from the process. There will be no reminder sent to parents regarding scheduling or the information night.

When all the requirements are met, the student’s application will be placed in the “lottery”. **All applicants will be notified by early May of their acceptance into the program.** Applicants not selected for enrollment will be notified by the administrator if openings occur after the lottery. Late applications may be considered if all applicants that completed the full registration process are exhausted. These late applicants are subject to administrative approval.

If an applicant turns down placement, and would like to re-apply for the following year, 2008-2009, you will need to complete the entire application process, including all visits and meetings, the following year.

Eagle Rock Multi-Age Program is directed by **Mrs. Judy Kay Harris**, who is also the Room 3 classroom teacher at Eagle Rock. Parent Volunteer Obligations

Each family will be required to volunteer 60 hours per school year for the first child enrolled. For each additional child the hours will increase by 15 hours. For example if you have two children in the program you would need to complete 75 hours and if you have three it would be a commitment of 90 hours.

CLASSROOM CONFIGURATIONS

Currently, our program consists of three elementary multi-age classrooms. These grade level configurations are based on enrollment needs and may vary from year to year. We make every effort to keep well balanced classes, based on equal grade levels, gender, and ability levels.

Our current Kindergarten program at Eagle Rock is an all-day, tuition based program. The current tuition for the 2004-2005 school year is \$2500 per year (paid over 10 months). These costs are subject to change from year to year.

In order to assure that the developmental needs of all our students are met, placement of students is subject to faculty assessment during the first month of school.
