Application Procedures and Policies

TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

All applicants must complete and sign the enclosed application materials and return them to Eagle Rock **no later than March 3, 2008**. All complete applications will be considered equally and placed into the “lottery”. ***FAMILIES MUST ATTEND ALL REQUIRED PARENT/ STUDENT MEETINGS OR YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE PLACED INTO THE LOTTERY.***

If opening should occur after the “lottery”, the pool of applicants that completed the application process will be considered first, late applicants may be considered on a space availability basis and will be subject to the administrator’s approval.

Other factors may affect the acceptance of your application status including the staff’s evaluation of the educational needs of our current students, sibling preference, and the need to maintain an overall gender balance in grade levels.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANT PROCESS:

Parents are **required** to schedule and attend the following application activities:

- Parent Observation Visit (10:00AM – adults only please) Visits are currently available January 14, 16, 18, 22, 24, and February 4, 6, 8, 12, 14, 25, 27, 29.
- Student & Parent Visit (K and 1st March 12th 4:00pm) (2nd through 5th March 13th 4:00pm)
- Parent Information Night March 6th (6-7pm at Eagle Rock)
- It is the parents’ responsibility to schedule the observations and visitations **by calling the school office at (425) 844-4900**. Parent observation visit must be completed by March 3rd. Failure to meet the requirements may result in the student’s name being dropped from the process. There will be no reminder sent to parents regarding the information night.

When all the requirements are met, the student’s application will be placed in the “lottery”. **All applicants will be notified by early April of their acceptance into the program.** Applicants not selected for enrollment will be notified by the administrator if openings occur after the lottery. Late applications may be considered if all applicants that completed the process are exhausted. These late applicants are subject to administrative approval.

If an applicant turns down the placement or is not selected in the lottery process for the current year, and would like to reapply for the following year 2009-2010, you will need to complete the entire application process, including all visits and meetings the following year.

Eagle Rock K-5 Multi-Age Program is directed by **Mrs. Judy Harris**, who is also the room 3 teacher at Eagle Rock. Parent Volunteer Obligations

Each family will be required to volunteer 60 hours per school year for the first child enrolled. For each additional child the hours will increase by 15. For example if you have two children in the program you would need to complete 75 hours and if you have three it would be a commitment of 90 hours.

Classroom Configurations

Currently, our program consists of three multi-age classrooms. These grade level configurations are based on enrollment needs and may vary from year to year. We make every effort to keep well balanced classes, based on equal grade levels, gender, and ability levels.

Our Kindergarten program at Eagle Rock is an all-day, tuition based program. The current tuition for the 2007-2008 school year is \$2500 per year (paid over 10 months). A deposit of \$250.00 is required at the time of enrollment. These costs are subject to change from year to year.

In order to assure that the developmental needs of our students are met placement of students is subject to faculty assessment during the first month of school
